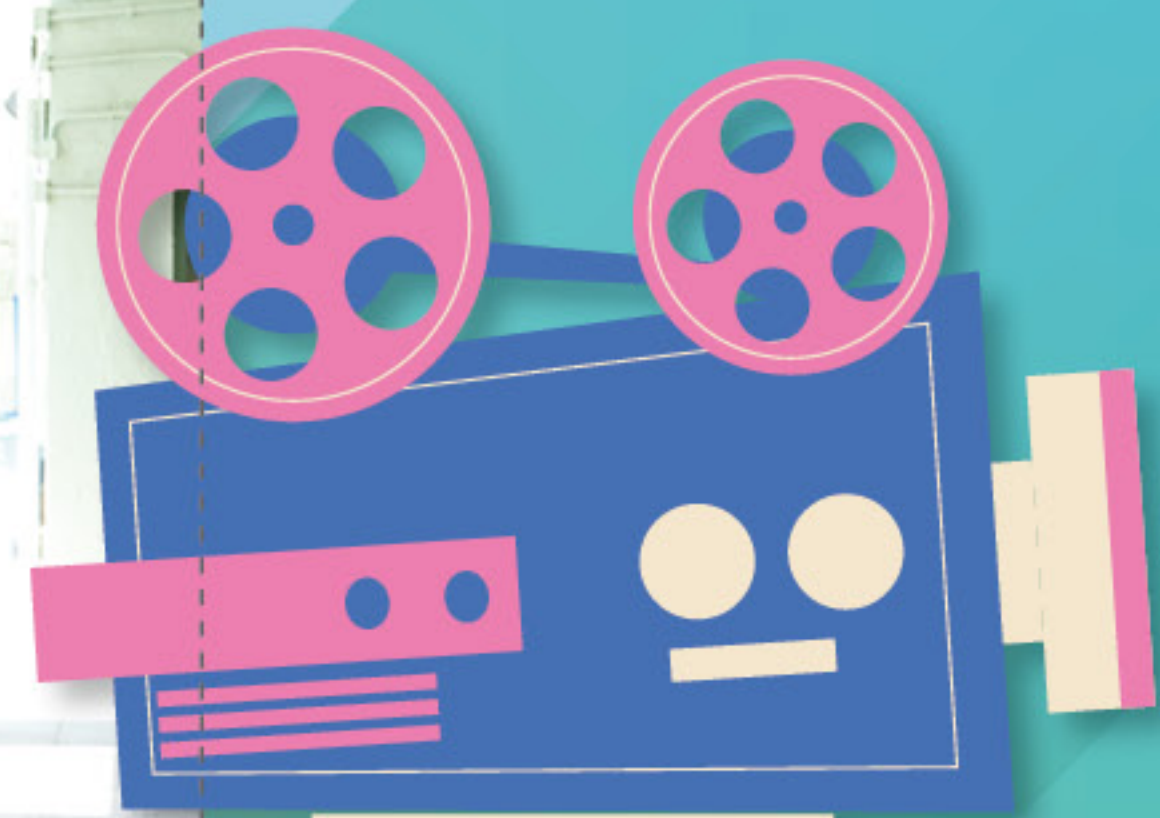

A Lonely Transferred High School Student

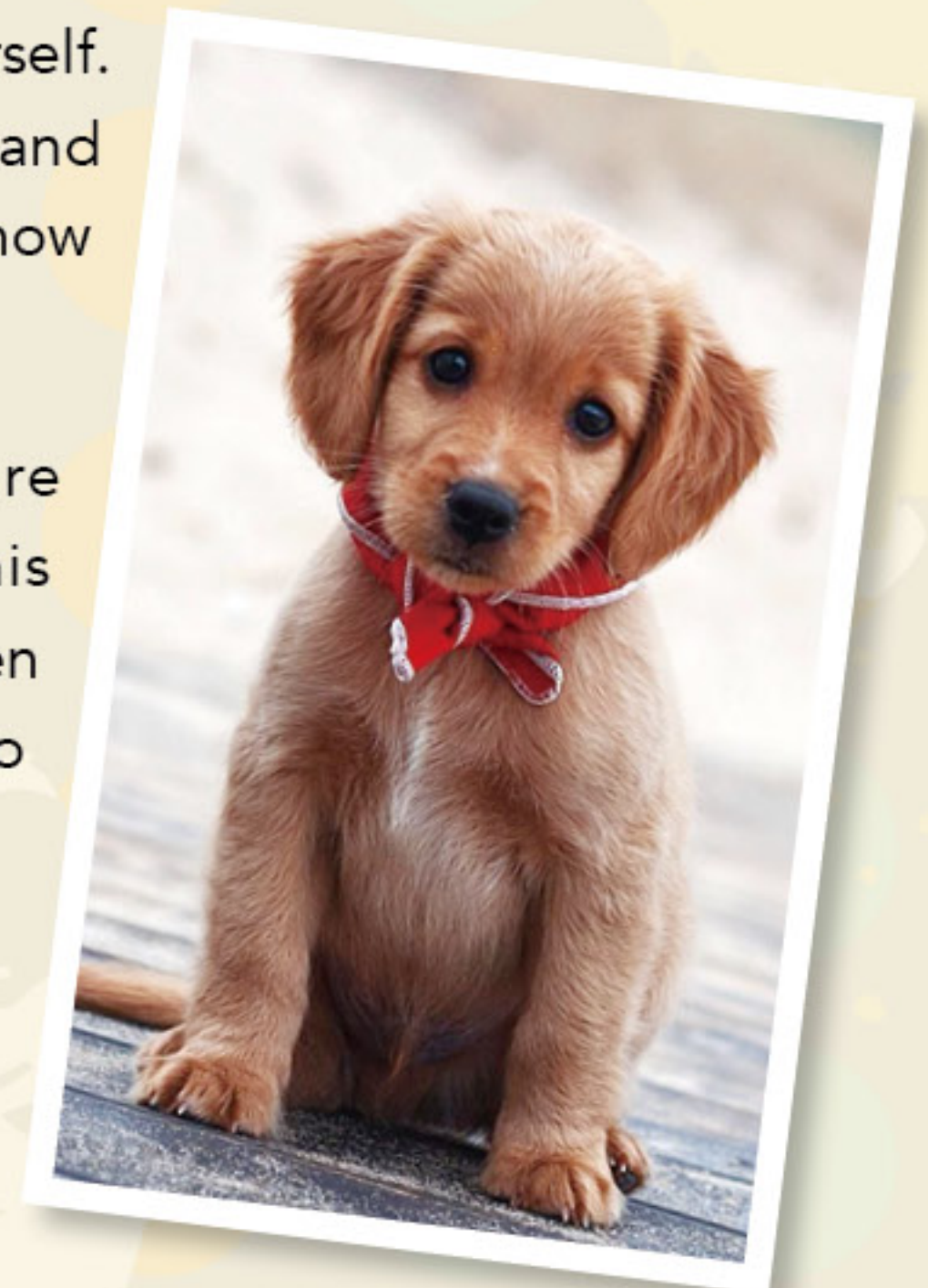

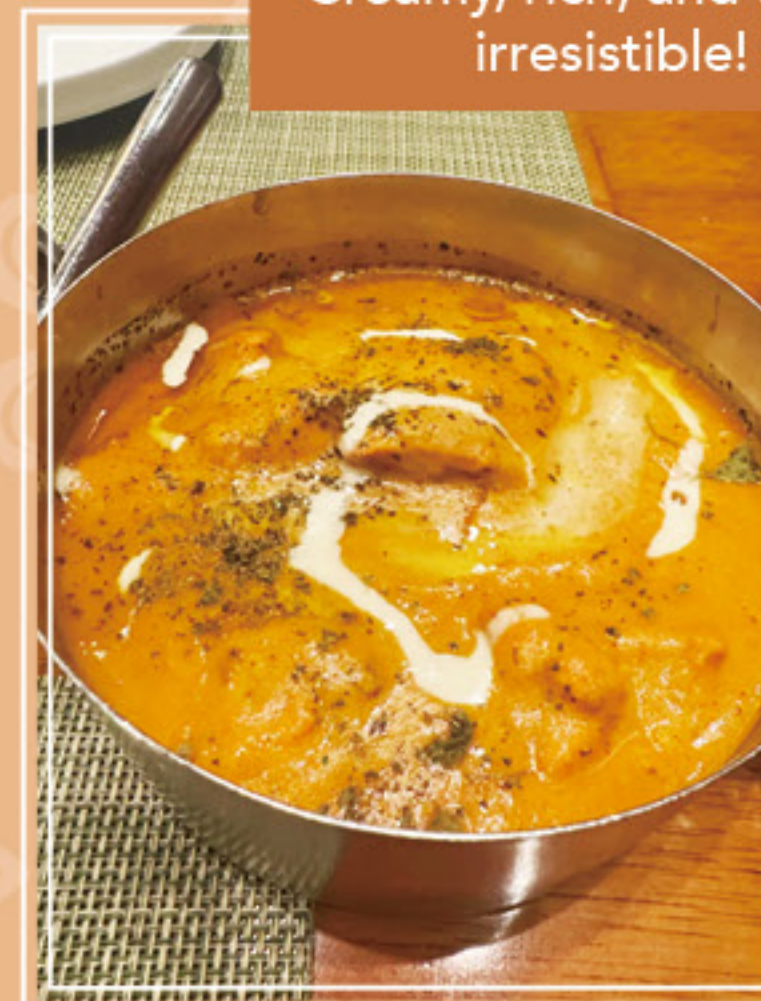

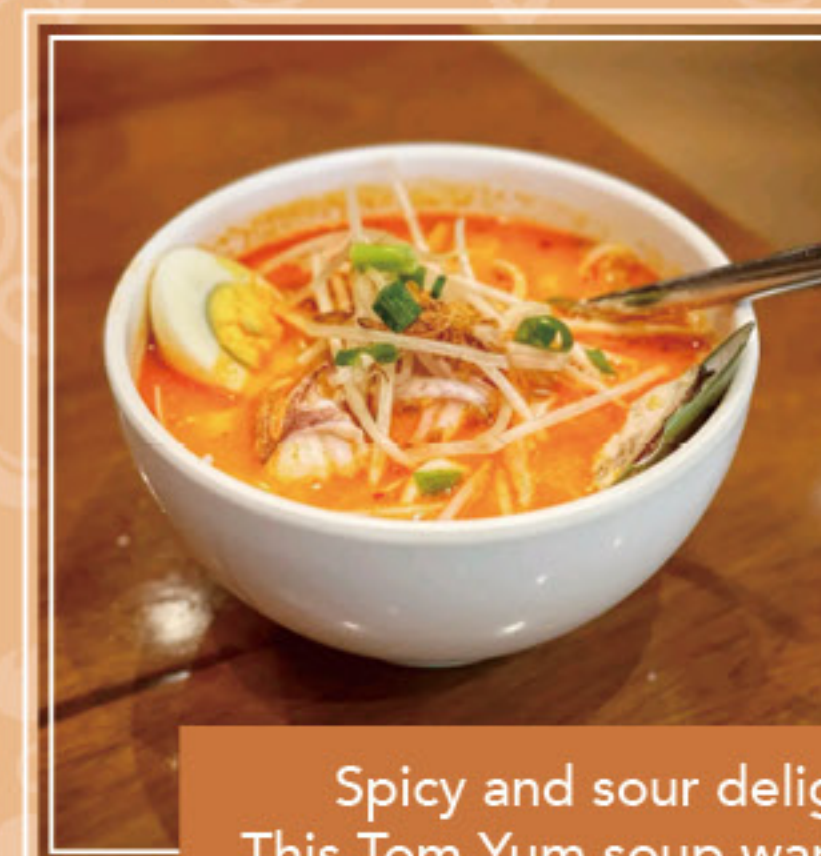

Food Review of Chilli Lime

I visited Chilli Lime for lunch with four classmates from the English Society and three of our English teachers. It was a typical day, so we were able to get a table without any wait.

Inside the restaurant, there were plenty of seating options, including round tables, four-person tables, and outdoor dining areas. We opted for a round table. For my meal, I ordered chicken tikka as a starter, phat kaphrao as the main dish, and a refreshing apple juice. The apple juice was garnished with a slice of green apple and tasted incredibly fresh.

The chicken tikka was vibrant orange and had a mild spiciness that I found enjoyable. For the main course, the phat kaphrao featured a generous helping of stir-fried minced meat topped with a sunny-side-up egg on rice. The meat was sweet and juicy, and when paired with the rice and egg, it made for a satisfying meal—I finished every bite without any leftovers.

The staff were friendly and patient, taking the time to explain the set lunch options and even accommodating my request to adjust the main dish from spicy to sweet. The atmosphere was warm and inviting, making it a great spot to gather with friends and family.

Tucked away, Chilli Lime offers a dining experience that blends a charming atmosphere, excellent service, and delicious Southeast Asian cuisine. As soon as I entered, I felt warmly welcomed. It was an exquisite blend of spicy, sour, and creamy notes, with a hint of lime. The addition of carbonara gave the dish a rich texture. It was exceptionally sweet, with a strong black tea base that lent it a rich and creamy texture. While I appreciated its unique flavour, I found it a bit too sweet for my liking. As a Hong Konger, I tend to prefer the more balanced and less sugary flavour of Hong Kong milk tea.

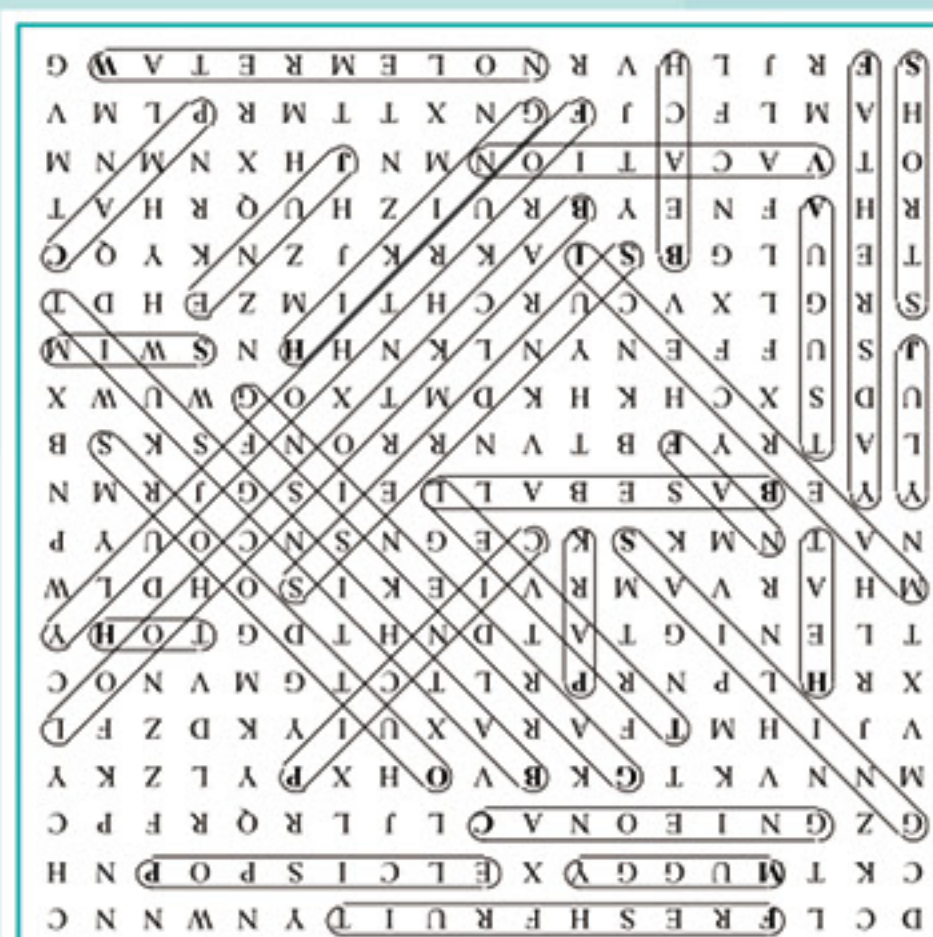
